- Lasting or irreparable reputational damage



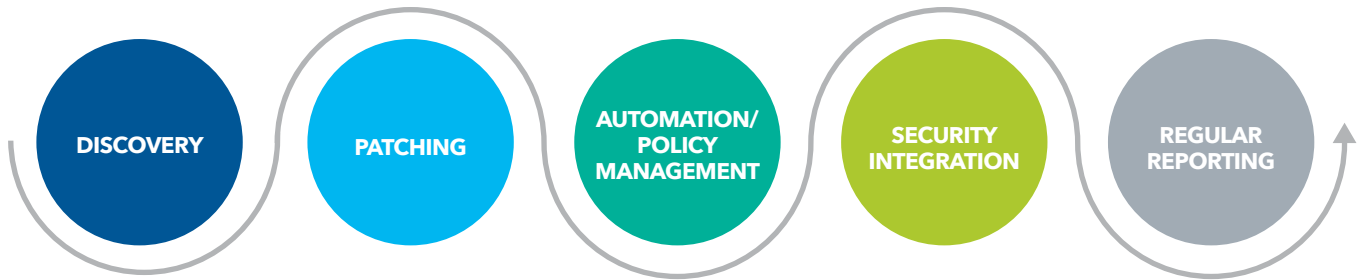
